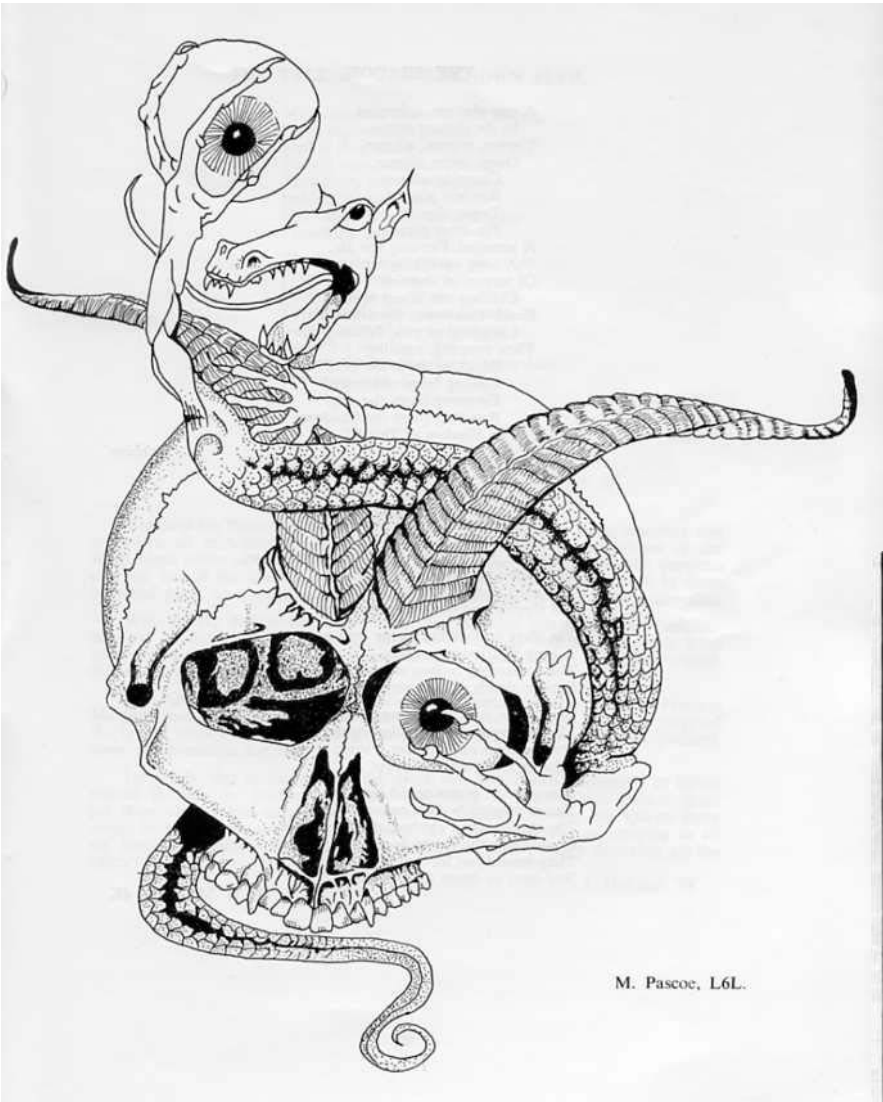


Class of '81 Reunion being planned for 2011

Deaths (recently notified)

Robert John Kenneth Rundell (1931-37) has died. (News from Norman Rundell)

It is with regret that I have to tell you that my brother, Robert John Kenneth Rundell M.C. M.A., (Rundell secundus), of 1931 to 1937, died on Monday 8th March. He was 90 and for many years had spent much of his time in St.Petersborough, Russia. At school he won scholarships to Oxford,Wadham College, served in the Army during the war, and spent the majority of his life working for the Moral Rearmament movement with which he was involved in Russia.

Michael Wilson (1948-57) died on 3rd September 2009.

Ronald Alan Griffin (19) died in August 2008.
