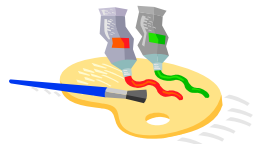

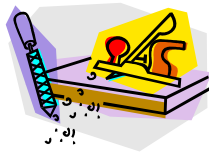
Art and DT work produced by Prep pupils will be on display in

will also be entertained by some of the school's budding musicians.

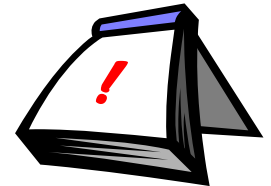
Refreshments will be available for parents visiting the Exhibition from 3.30 pm in the Dining Hall.
