We want to reassure you that following the decision of the Government to instruct all schools to close, our main aim at Truro School is to still continue to deliver the best possible teaching service that circumstances will allow to your children. Furthermore, we will endeavour to continue to provide the highest level of pastoral and other support to your children, and the whole family community of which we are all a part, during these extremely difficult times. Whilst other education settings may be preparing to offer 'care' services, we are working to ensure we are delivering quality education services to continue your children's progress.

We recognise that in these unprecedented times, depending on the nature of your work, your household income may be affected and you may be concerned about school fees. At this point we are following the Government advice closely about support that will be available for businesses and individuals. As a charity we are in the process of assessing what the advice means for our operations, but the majority of our costs are salaries and establishment costs which we are unable to reduce to any significant extent.

We do however realise that the Government support position is not very clear at this current time, so we may have to wait until it becomes clearer before we can provide full responses.
