We have been very impressed by our pupils this term. The vast majority are taking full advantage of the wide variety of activities available and subject staff regularly report about their impressive contributions to class. The 3rd year have been involved in a year group quiz on Wednesdays and we have a creative Thursday where they have been sharing pictures and experiences of a wide range of activities and hobbies. All fourth years have had one-to-one meetings with their tutors this term and tutors have been impressed by the mature way in which the vast majority of the year are engaging with online learning.
