Sue Loydell is a fine artist, educator and community practitioner with over 25 years' experience working in the secondary & higher education sectors. Originally training in combined arts (specialising on costume design for dance), she works in mixed media, textiles, print and sculpture.

Her fine art work focuses on landscape and the sea, using layers of texture and colour in response to the rapidly changing weather and seasons of Cornwall. Many of her pieces derive from time spent mono-printing, creating collages and experimentation with materials which then slowly develop into semi-abstract responses.

'My work focuses on landscape and the sea, using layers of texture and colour in response to the rapidly changing weather and seasons of Cornwall. Many of the pieces derive from time spent walking and observing the landscape near my home by a creek on the Carrick Roads. My creative process includes mono-printing, collage and experimentation with a variety of mark-making materials which then slowly develop into layered contours and horizons. I am interested in the relationship between colour and movement and how these change at different times of the day or season.'

Since 2017, Sue has been a member of artist the City of Lights artistic team, creating large-scale lanterns and artworks for parades and events across Cornwall. Sue also delivers workshops in schools and the community specialising in 'aspiration-raising' and well-being, working with organisations such as Cornwall Council (One Vision), Headstart Kernow, Truro City Council, KEAP and Boot Up! Outdoor Education.
