Dear Parents, Carers and Guardians

Today our school was awash with colour, fashion and style as pupils and staff took part in non-uniform day to raise funds for two important charities: Young Minds and The Wave project. Thank you to the Charity Team for leading Chapel Services this week to raise awareness about the important work these charities do to support young people with mental health.

Next week is Children's Mental Health Week; an awareness week to empower, equip, and give a voice to all children and young people.

At school, our Pastoral team are always available to listen and respond to pupils' concerns and will act to ensure the very best outcomes for our pupils. In all areas of school life, our pupils are encouraged to show compassion and empathy towards others in everyday actions and decisions. A simple act of kindness or a smile can really make a difference to somebody's day. Next week some of our teachers will draw on their own learning to present to colleagues during our Twilight Professional Learning session. Across the evening, colleagues will share good practice to support innovation and creativity in the classroom. These sessions put learners at the heart of teaching and learning development and staff welcome the opportunity to work alongside their colleagues to explore different approaches to classroom practice. Pasties and tea provide the additional fuel for the evening!

As I finish writing this, the sun is shining and there is a subtle sense that Spring may be just around the corner. For some of our pupils, warmer climates are on the horizon. Our 4th and 5th Year pupils are in Alicante this week to immerse themselves in Spanish life and language. Next week, our surfers travel to Morrocco to enjoy half term in the waves, and, closer to home, a group are heading to Dartmoor for their Ten Tors day walk. All of these trips are great opportunities for our pupils to experience new challenges, learn new skills, and form lasting friendships.

Dynamics of Lava Flows

Our 4th Year geology pupils have been exploring lava flows and the various factors influencing their behaviour. By simulating some specific volcanic conditions, they have gained valuable insights into the impact of slope and magma composition on the destructive potential of volcanoes.

To conduct their experiments, pupils substituted lava with strawberry jelly, which was heated to different temperatures to adjust its viscosity. They then focused on studying how the angle of slope affected the flow of "lava" and measured a response to different angles. Additionally, they explored the influence of lava composition by introducing sand and observed its impact on the flow dynamics.



Homage to the Humble Croissant

MFL pupils were invited to showcase their creativity by composing a short poem or prose about this beloved crescent-shaped pastry.

In class, pupils looked at the work of French poet Francis Ponge, known for his ability to capture the beauty of everyday objects in his poetry, including his renowned poem "Le Pain." Drawing inspiration from Ponge's work, pupils were encouraged to craft their own pieces of writing.
